50-State Legal Surveys

The Council offers eight 50-state legal surveys to help its members navigate the changing policy landscape of statutes and regulations that affect the insurance industry. These resources (formerly known as the “libraries”) are available on the Council’s website – and are a great first step in addressing issue-specific concerns. The surveys cover the following key areas:

- Producer’s Fees & Commissions
- Consulting Licensing
- Data Breach Notification
- Surplus Lines
- Anti-Rebating Laws and Regulations
- Producer Fiduciary Responsibilities for Trust Accounts
- State Balance Billing Protections
- State Data Security Framework
- State Single Payer Implementation Tracker
- State Single Payer Studies Tracker

Federal Legislative Trackers

In addition to the legal surveys, the Council maintains several real-time legislative trackers on issues of importance at the federal level. We are currently tracking the following topics:

- Federal Single-Payer/Public Option Legislation
- Federal Legislation Impacting the Affordable Care Act and Other Healthcare Reforms
- Federal Drug Pricing Legislation

The Council also maintains legislative trackers on issues of importance at the state level on the following topics:

NAIC/NCOIL Coverage

Beyond the formal Surveys and Trackers, the Council covers various NAIC and NCOIL Committee, Subcommittee, Working Group, and Task Force meetings in virtual and in-person formats throughout the calendar year. We maintain readouts that include relevant details regarding Commissioner and industry comments as well as important activity. These readouts are circulated as necessary and cover the following topics:

In addition to the readouts by topic area of various meetings throughout the year, we also produce reports of the national NAIC and NCOIL meetings that are conducted 3-4 times a year.
